Team Swim Caps: Required for all competition

You may contact <u>Brier Nelson</u> to make arrangements to purchase your team swim cap during the season. The Coaches have a limited supply on deck during meets and practice.

Each swimmer needs a team swim cap for practices and competitions. It is highly recommended that every swimmer purchase a few spare team swim caps to keep in their swim bag. Each cap costs \$3.00 (latex) \$11.00 (silicone)

Coaches will have only a limited supply of extra swim caps with them on deck at competitions for emergency purposes. In the case of a swim cap emergency, a swimmer will be supplied a team swim cap by their coach and the swimmer's escrow account will be charged for the purchase of the cap.

ESCROW

We are just starting the Long Course season and there will not be much activity in your escrow account yet. However, once the meets start, you will see the meet fees being charged here. It is very important that you monitor your escrow balance throughout the long course season to make sure there is enough money in the account to cover these meet fees. Please remember for the two home swim meets this summer that all swimmers will be entered into the meet. If your child will not be swimming, it is important for you to let their coach know this ahead of time so they will not enter them into the meet and you can avoid the meet fees for the home meets.

You must be logged in to the website (www.ppdswim.org) in order to find your current escrow balance and to see all charges against your escrow account. Click on "My Account" and then "My Invoice/Payment" on the left side of the screen. This will bring up a screen with your Account Charges Summary. Your total outstanding balance is shown on the left side of this box. This is your current family escrow balance. If the account balance is negative, you currently have funds in your escrow account. If the account balance is positive, you need to send a check to cover the amount due (and additional funds for any upcoming meets).

If you click on "Current Invoice Summary", you will see all items charged and all funds deposited into your escrow account for the current month. The website generates "invoices" each month on the 1st. (This is a change from the past when invoices were generated on the 21st of the month.) The meet fees are listed by meet and indicate the number of Individual events and the number of Relay events that each swimmer was charged for each meet. Please note that if you signed up for a meet, but were unable to attend the meet, your escrow account will be charged because we must still pay the host team for entries submitted.

You can get a summary of the entire season's fees and deposits by clicking on "Billing History" and "Search on Billing/Payment History". Input beginning date of season and ending date of season. All charges for the season will be displayed.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR

Long course season 2011 has arrived. Below is some information about our away meets which are optional and our two summer meets which will be held at Birchwood Pool.

AWAY MEETS

If you sign your swimmer up for any away meets, be on the lookout for an E-mail about five days before the meet with timing assignments. Most swim clubs require visiting teams to time one lane for the whole meet. I will be asking two timers to cover the lane assigned to us. I try to break the assignments into shifts so you will not time the whole meet and only the session your swimmer is swimming.

If you cannot make your shift, please let me know as soon as possible so I can find a replacement. By not showing up you are putting the team in a hard spot - please be considerate and show up or let me know ahead of time if there is a problem.

HOSTED MEETS

PPD will host two meets this summer. One parent needs to volunteer every session their swimmer is swimming. If you have swimmers in different sessions we ask that you volunteer at both sessions each day your children are swimming. There will be a job signup on our website about 3 weeks before each meet. I will notify everyone when it is available. The signup will stay open until the week of the meet. If you have not signed up I will assign a job to your family. It makes it easier for everyone if you sign up while it is still open.

PPD is know for hosting great meets because we always have great volunteers, I'm sure it will be the same this season!
